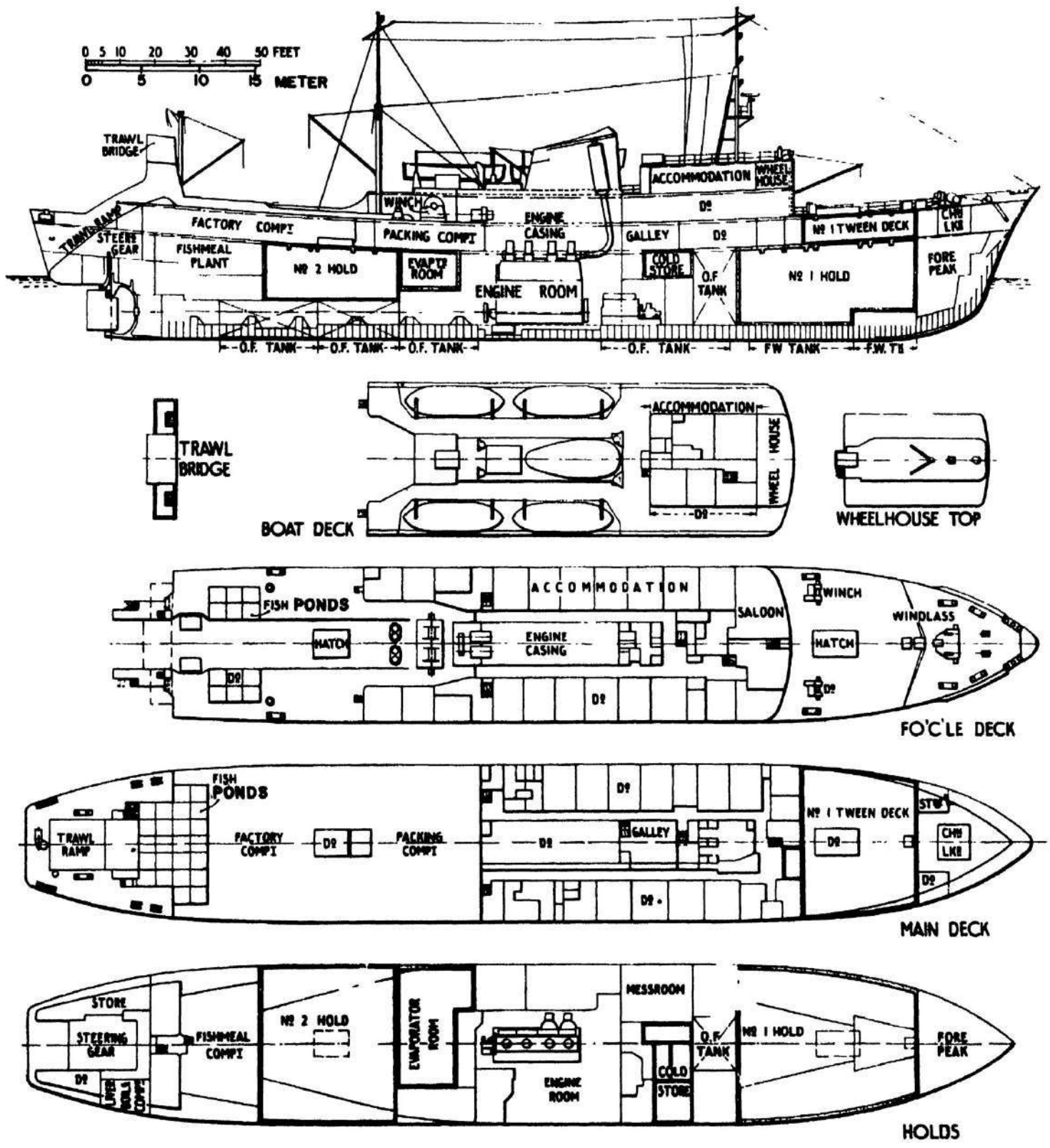


Fig. 604. Arrangement of Fairtry
